We welcome new voice instructor **Evan Westfal** to the Conservatory fold. Evan has been cast as Sir Joseph Porter in Opera NOUVA's new production of *HMS* 

*Pinafore*, running February 22-26 at the Capitol Theatre, Fort Edmonton Park.

Violinist **Frank Ho** had a busy fall term performing multiple recitals with fellow faculty members **David Tutt** and **Bianca Baciu**, as well as Peter Janciewicz of Mount Royal University. Repertoire included works by Bach, Mozart, Franck, Richard Strauss, Ravel and Stravinsky, together with modern works by Janciewicz and Eric Ewazen. This term, Frank does some travelling, leading a master class at the University of Ottawa, and adjudicating at festivals in various centres around Alberta and BC.

Dan Davis directs the Yardbird Suite Jazz Orchestra on Sunday, February 26 at 2 pm. The concert features some of Edmonton's finest jazz artists, and includes works by jazz luminaries Jim McNeely, Thad Jones and an original work in the big band style by Mr. Davis himself!

The fledgling Alberta Symphony Orchestra, under Emilio De Mercato's direction, continues to evolve. In December, armed with a chamber choir, soloists and a string quintet, the ensemble closed the "Celebrate the Season" festival at the Alberta Legislature to a captive audience of some 1100 people. More ASO events are in the works for summer and fall.

As a pianist, Emilio tours several Alberta cities this winter, including a lecture and master class at Grande Prairie Regional College, and a solo recital there on March 15.
